REGULATIONS, FLOORBALL

1. Time schedule. Floorball competitions will be held in TU Sports Hall (Ujula 4) from May 21 to May 23, 2010 at 9 a.m. Technical meeting will take place on May 20 at 6.00 p.m. in Accreditation Centre.

2. Program. Men's and women`s competitions will be held. Maximum number of teams 12 for men and 8 for women competition.

3. Rules. Official IFF regulations will be used with next modifications:

3.1. The duration of the game is 2 x 20 min. It is played on the “uninterrupted time” principle. The break between the half-times is 2 min.

3.2. In case the playoff game ends in a tie, 3 penalty shootouts will be scored by both teams.

4. Number of players in a team. The team consists of up to **20 players**. There will be 5 field players and a goalkeeper on the field at a time.

5. Number of games. Depending on the number of participating teams a team can play several games a day.

6. Counting. Teams will be classified according to their win-loss records, namely two (2) points for each game won, one (1) point for each game tie and zero (0) points for a game lost and (-1) for a game lost by forfeit. In every level of the competition (the pools, intermediate tournament, the final tournament etc.) the standings will be determined by the number of points (collected as described previously). In case two teams have equal number of points, the result of the game between them is decisive. In case three or more teams gather the equal number of points, the results of the games between these teams, and in case of a tie, better difference of scored goals, will be decisive.

7. System. It has been decided to play in pools and to apply the round-system. There will be 3-5 teams in each pool. According to the results in pools, the teams will continue playing in the intermediate tournament, 3-4 teams in each group. The best 3 or 4 teams will play in the final tournament.

8. Insurance and medical service. The participants must have the appropriate insurance to cover travel and participation, as they are not the responsibility of the OC. The OC will insure the first aid at the competition venues for all the accredited persons.
