REGULATIONS, TABLE TENNIS

1. Schedule. Table tennis competition will take place in Tartu, in Turu tänava spordihall (address: Turu tn 8, 51013 Tartu), from May 21 to May 22 2010, at 10 a.m. The hall will be open for warm-up at 9:15 a.m. On Friday at 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. is lunchtime and award ceremony is approximately at 5:30 p.m. Award ceremony o Saturday is approximately at 3 p.m. and lunch is after competition. Technical meeting will take place on May 20 at 8 p.m. in EMU main building (Kreutzwaldi 1) room 033. .

2. Program: The tournament will take place in men's singles and woman's singles and also in men's, women's and mixed doubles. There is no limit to the number of participants.

3. Rules. Tournament will be played according to the international rules of ITTF. All games will be played best of five.

4. System On the first day all singles will be played and on the second day the doubles. Players will be seated in the tournament table taking into account their palce in their country current ranking. In singles all places will be played out. Doubles will be played in tournament system in which first best five places will be played out. Singles result will be taken into account when placing doubles into the tournament brackets. The head referee takes the right to change the tournament system if the number of competitors differs a lot from expected.

5. Insurance and medical service. The participants must have the appropriate insurance to cover travel and participation, as they are not the responsibility of the OC. The OC will insure the first aid at the competition venues for all the accredited persons.
