REGULATIONS, VOLLEYBALL

1. Time schedule. Volleyball tournament will take place in Tartu EMÜ Sports Hall (Kreutzwaldi 3) from May 21 to May 23, 2010 at 9 a.m. Arrival to Tartu on May 20. Technical meeting will take place on May 20 at 6 p.m. in Accreditation Centre.

2. Program. There will be men's and women's tournament. Maximum number of teams for men is 16 and for women 12.

3. Rules. The competitions will be held according to the international (FIVB) rules with the following modifications:

3.1. Matches will be held according to the system "the best of the three"! Final matches according to system „the best of the five“

3.2. Third (in final matches fifth) game lasts until 15 points or until 2 point difference. Change of sides after the 8th point.

4. Number of players. The team consists of up to 12 players.

5. Number of matches. Depending on the number of participating teams, a team can play several games a day.

6. Counting. Teams will be classified according to their win-loss records, namely two (2) points for each game won, one (1) point for each game lost (including lost by default) and zero (0) points for a game lost by forfeit. In the pools the standings will be determined by the number of points (collected as described previously). In case of equal number of points the best team is determined by the overall ratio of games won and lost, in case of equal ratios all points will be decisive. In case both ratios of games and points are equal, the results of the games between the teams will be decisive.

Places 13-16 and 1-4 will be played using semi-finals and finals.

Teams in places 9-12, who drop in the first round of the play-off and teams in places 5-8, who drop in the quarterfinals will be classified according to their place in the Group Stage. In case of equal place the standings will be determined by the number of points earned in the Group Stage (collected as described previously). In case of equal number of points the best team is determined by the overall ratio of games won and lost, in case of equal ratios all points will be decisive. In case both ratios of games and points are equal, they will share their place.

7. System. The round-system will be used. There will be up to 6 teams in each pool. If necessary, the intermediate tournaments will be held to establish 3-6 teams who will play in the final tournament.

8. Insurance and medical service. The participants must have the appropriate insurance to cover travel and participation, as they are not the responsibility of the OC. The OC will insure the first aid at the competition venues for all the accredited persons.
